Project Description

Black Youth Protecting Black Peace Project (BYPBP) identifies gaps and opportunities for addressing black youth mental health. BYPBP will focus on addressing the mental health needs of Black youth ages 10-17 years old in Stockton, California, by ensuring that institutional and systemic policies respond to root causes of mental health problems and provide Black youth appropriate services that are trauma informed. It will focus on identifying, assessing, and improving policies within three systems that interact with children and youth: a) the juvenile justice system, b) the education system, and c) the Black Church and organizations that serve Black youth. This project will identify, analyze, and assess the juvenile justice system's impact on the mental health of Black youth, change current practices that criminalize mental health, and implement policies that are restorative and public health based.

AAAWLC announces a Program Manager (PM) position for the Black Youth Protecting Black Peace Project.
